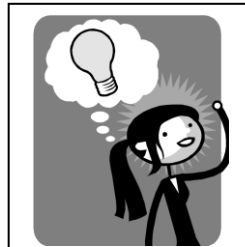
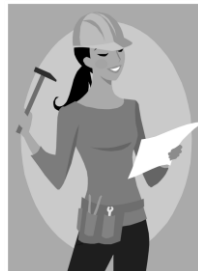

When the idea for an invention first occurs it is called the conception of the invention.



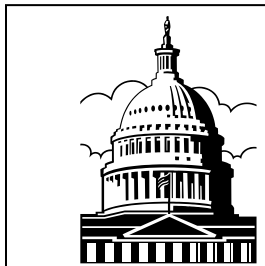
A prototype or test version of the invention can help perfect the idea.

To obtain a patent, an inventor files a patent application with the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

The patent will stop others from copying the invention for 20 years.
